III. Treasurer's Report

- Current balance = \$16,265.08. Total dues received 2018 = 7,326.04. Nicki will recreate Annual Picnic budget for future years. She thinks the 2019 budget should be larger. Need invoice for directory printing.

IV. Old Business

- Dumpster Day - Ryan to ask Gina for update and to send reminder of what can be put in the dumpsters
